The full day of fun begins at 10:00 am with the one-hour show at the Ivy Tech John Waldron Arts Center. Then, it's a one-block walk to WonderLab for lunch break and science fun. The initial dates available for this combo package offer are June 20, 21, 27 and 28.

The combo package requires at least one adult to chaperone each ten campers, and a minimum of ten campers to be eligible for the package. The discount price is \$12 per person, including participating adults. No other promotions or discounts offered by either partner apply to the combo summer package. Lunch is not provided.
